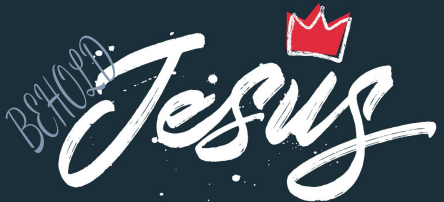

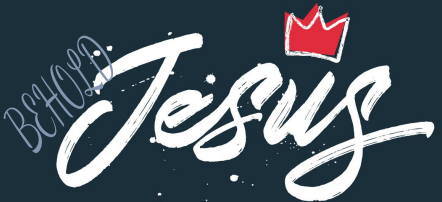


# The Questions You Need to Answer

- With sincere repentance?

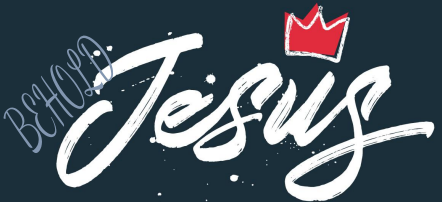


# The Questions You Need to Answer

- Restoration of your spiritual relationship?

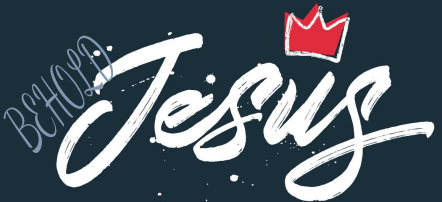


# The Questions You Need to Answer

4. What are you believing?

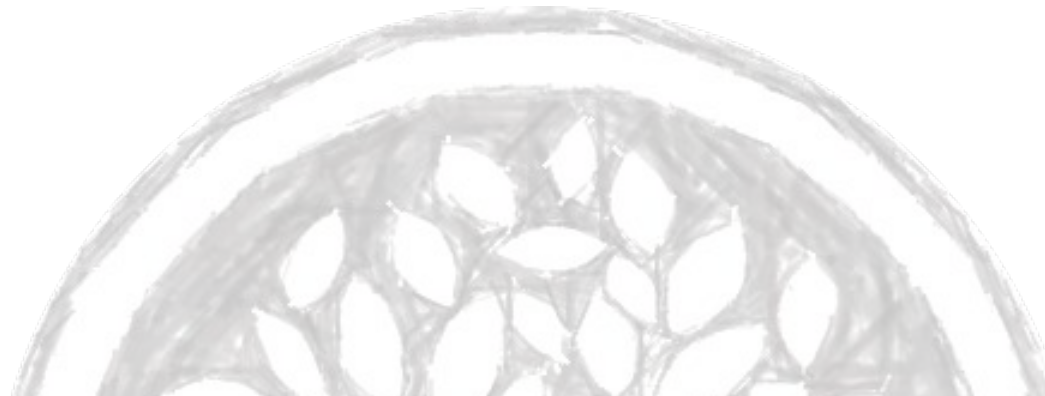
- The lie that you are beyond forgiveness?
