





A Men's Bible Study was offered in the fall at the Goodfield Building on Wednesday mornings.






Young Adult Ministry

YOUNG ADULT BIBLE STUDY



JOY CLUB FOR KIDS WITH SPECIAL NEEDS


Dedicated helpers provided the extra assistance and attention needed so kids with special needs were able to participate in the various children's ministries.

WHAT DOES JOY CLUB MEAN TO US?



My son Jason is 5 yearsold and is diagnosed with Autism level 2. He has a lot of sensory needs, requires supportive assistance, and communicates with total communication (his AAC device, sign language, and beginning speech.)

When Jason was first diagnosed, our world became small, and I felt like we were pushed to the bottom of a hole with no light in sight. God provided a way for resources and

therapy, but socially our world grew smaller. Before JOY Club, it had been nearly 4 years since I was able to go to service. My faith was always with me. It was the only thing that kept me going in my darkest hours. Having the ability to sit through a service, or Sunday school has restored my sense of community and helped my journey as a Christian woman, finding JOY in this crazy thing called life. JOY in Autism, JOY in the people and gifts that God so uniquely gives us all.

Jason has also found his JOY. Joy Club was his first introduction to socialization beyond a therapy room. He is learning about Jesus and developing social skills. He loves to pray before every meal! I picked him up from Sunday school today, my once uncomfortable and overwhelmed boy is now so at ease.

We now have a village, something I never thought we would have. JOY Club has been able to connect us to resources outside of church, celebrates our successes, and has really helped us find JOY in life. Thank you!


