God wants His people to be appropriately concerned about remaining faithful to Him.

4 Finally, then, brothers, we ask and urge you in the Lord Jesus, that as you received from us how you ought to walk and to please God, just as you are doing, that you do so more and more.

If God's people are to remain faithful, then they must be concerned about
Ongoing obedience (1-9)
Point to Ponder: still more (1 Thess. 4:1)
Emerging idolatry (10-20)
Point to Ponder: yourselves from idols (1 John 5:21)
Preserving unity (21-29)
Point to Ponder: Be to maintain unity (Eph. 4:1-6)
Remembering truth (30-34)

Point to Ponder: Never \_\_\_\_\_ God's benefits (Ps. 103)

#### **Reflection Questions:**

- 1. What are you most concerned about (good or bad) at the start of each day? How did today's lesson help you think about setting godly priorities?
- 2. How is idolatry a threat to faithfulness? Can you identify any idols in your own life? What steps can you take this week to guard yourself from these idols?
