### **Growing Deeper**

1. What makes Rahab's inclusion in the hall of faith so shocking? Does it surprise you to see her in such a prominent position in this chapter? What does this tell us about God's character toward sinners who put their faith in Him?
2. Read James 2:14-16. What is the relationship between faith and good works? How does Rahab serve as a timely example of this truth?
3. Read Matthew 1:5. What role does Rahab play in the greater storyline of Scripture? How does her salvation provide the hope for our salvation?
4. Why is Rahab's faith a fitting example for our author to end this chapter with? How does she offer encouragement to those who are struggling to endure and who are being tempted to walk away from Christ?

**Heart Preparation:** Prepare your heart for worship on 09/07 by reading Hebrews 11:32-40.

**Family Discipleship:** As a family, map out your family tree as best as possible. Explain to your children the purpose of genealogy and help them see their connection to previous generations in your family. Then, take them to Matthew 1 and read the genealogy of Jesus. Ask them if they recognize any names from Hebrews 11? Make sure to draw their attention to Rahab! As a family, thank and praise God for His wisdom to include all these men and women in the family line that produced the Savior!

**Prayer Prompt:** Our heavenly Father, thank You for the gift of Jesus Christ! We praise You for loving us so much that You sent Your only Son into this world so that we would not perish in our sin. In this race of faith, may we fix our eyes firmly on Jesus – the author and perfecter of our salvation! Amen.
