

When Grace Knocks

Revelation 3:14-22 – *Pastor Josh Gerber*

MAIN POINT: Grace is knocking, and you are invited to respond to Christ's invitation for sweet fellowship.

1. Grace interrupts our comfortable drift (14-16).

2. Grace reveals your honest need (17).

3. Grace invites you to the table (18-22).

Discussion Questions:

1. In what specific areas of your life (your schedule, your finances, your private habits) does Jesus' "knock" feel more like an unwanted intrusion than a welcome visit?
2. Why is it so tempting for us to live in a world of spiritual "maybes" and "we'll sees" (especially regarding New Year's resolutions)? How would your daily anxiety change if you truly viewed Jesus as the "Final Word" over your life?
3. Can you identify a recent situation where you refused the "sovereign help of heaven" because you felt you had the resources to handle it on your own? What was the "cost" of that independence in terms of your peace or energy?
4. In our modern culture, what are the "white garments" or "gold" we try to show off to prove we are doing well? How can we tell if we are using physical comforts to mask a spiritual bankruptcy?
5. How does it feel to realize that Jesus' invitation to the table isn't based on your "room temperature," but on His persistent love?
6. As you look at the year ahead, what would "opening the door" actually look like for you this week? Does it mean confessing a hidden sin, handing over a specific worry, or simply admitting you are "naked" and need His covering?
