Points to Ponder

Application: Show no partiality in living out the gospel of Jesus Christ

Growing Deeper

1. Read James 2:1-13. Where might you be guilty (or at risk) of expressing partiality either in your evangelism or your fellowship with other believers? How does your mindset need to change as you consider the implications of Acts 10?
2. How can you faithfully enter the world of unbelievers without compromising on the gospel? How did Peter do this? How did Jesus practice this?
3. New Castle Bible church is richly diverse in its communities, districts, demographics, and backgrounds. How can you personally work toward greater unity with those who are different from you?
4. Read Ephesians 4:1-6. Based on this passage, what does it look like for the church to walk in gospel unity?

Heart Preparation: Prepare your heart for worship on 08/09 by reading and meditating on Acts 11:1-18.

Prayer Prompt: Father, forgive me for how I have unfaithfully expressed partiality in my Christian walk. Search me for any unclean or unloving attitude I might currently have toward those who are different from me. Help me to remember that all people are equally welcomed by the gospel of Jesus Christ. Amen.

Reaching Farther

Family: As a family, talk to your kids about the dangers of partiality. This is a good word to introduce into their vocabulary. You can help them understand this word by connecting it to the idea of favoritism. You can even ask them provoking questions they can relate to, such as, "is it right for mommy or daddy to have favorite children?" Help them understand why this would be wrong. Then, show them how God does not show favoritism through the gospel of Jesus Christ.

Community: Identify one person in this church and one person in your community (Christian or not) who are very different from you. Use this next week to express some form of impartial, gospel-centered love toward them.
