



You don't have to go far to find a good story.




Some stories we read in books. Some stories we live for real.



Some stories we stumble into.




There are lots of good stories. But one story is very special—a grand story about how everything came to life.



Let's start at the beginning with the One who made this special story: God.




Everything that is all around us was created by God.




From animals and nature, to planets and stars . . . and you.








God dressed the trees with leaves and taught brooks to babble.




God made the first people and breathed on them to wake them up to life.



The first people were named Adam and Eve. They loved each other and the world around them.




Most of all, Adam and Eve loved God. Everything was perfect.




But things aren't perfect anymore. God had an enemy named Satan. Satan wanted to mess up God's perfect world.




Satan tricked Adam and Eve into eating from the one tree from which God told them not to eat.

Our sin is a big deal, but God's love is bigger.




God promised that one day, someone would come rescue us from sin. Who would it be? It was God Himself!




God made Himself a baby, born to a young girl named Mary. She named Him Jesus.

Jesus started teaching about God's story and did amazing things called miracles to prove He was God.




Some people didn't like Jesus and lied to get Him in trouble and have Him killed on a cross.




Jesus could have stopped them, but He didn't. Because Jesus loved us so much, He chose to die for our sins.




Everyone who loved Jesus was so sad that He died.




Jesus' friends cried as they buried Him.




But three days later, Jesus came back to life! He came back to prove His love was bigger than sin!




This is the true story of how Jesus came to rescue us from sin, just as God promised.




God made another promise: that one day everything in the world will be perfect again.

“For Christ also suffered once for sins, the righteous for the unrighteous, that he might bring us to God.”


## RESTORATION
